We work in a **technology-neutral, market- and competition-oriented manner, focusing on implementation, risk reduction, job security and industrial value creation in Europe**.

The Problem: Great Technology, Hard Execution

Heavy industries (like steel, glass, and cement) cause about 30% of industrial emissions in Europe. To save the climate, these factories must change now. The technology and the money are ready. However, many of these huge construction projects fail or get delayed. This usually happens not because of the machinery, but because of outdated management, overwhelmed teams, and worried workers.

Our Solution: Hands-on Help in the Factory

We are a European non-profit organization (NGO). We do not just write theoretical reports; we go directly onto the shop floor. We help organize the complex process of rebuilding factories.

We work **technology-neutral**. This means: Whether a factory uses hydrogen or electricity, we make sure the new systems work in daily life.

The Value: Why is this important?

- **Secure Jobs:** We help European factories stay competitive. This keeps industrial jobs safe.
- **No Waste:** When projects fail, tax money and investments are lost. We prevent this by spotting risks early.
